For more than a month now we are experiencing the horror of unspeakable suffering, devastation and loss. We never imagined our children would have to hide from enemy bullets in their own native land. The challenges, uncertainty and distress experienced by Dzherelo's children with special needs and their heroic mothers, are immense.

Most of Dzherelo's 400 families have remained in Lviv. Our staff continue to provide aid and services to the families, helping them cope with profound stress and trauma. Dzherelo has also been a safe haven for over 200 children with special needs and their moms who fled intense bombing in Ukraine's eastern and southern regions. These internally displaced persons and refugee families are offered a place to stay at our Centre, which includes hot meals, psychological support, rehab and much needed comfort and care.

We are deeply grateful that from the first days of the war you offered humanitarian medical aid for our Dzherelo children and youth. The specialized medicines you generously provided, are crucial for their well-being, and your kindness has brought real comfort and hope to their parents as well. We realize and appreciate how much time, effort, hard work and coordination it took to organize, fund and deliver the medicines so quickly, efficiently, and successfully.
